The Stanton Lions Club is made up of community leaders. This organization allows us to work together to improve our community. We are a not-for-profit [501c] *Community Service Organization*. Stanton Lions are non-political, and no member receives compensation for their work with the Lions Club.

We are dedicated to helping those in need. Lions have focused on children, persons with hearing difficulty, and the visually challenged.

HISTORY

The Stanton Lions Club was chartered in 1947 with the goal of helping the community. Many of our members were involved in Orange County's booming agricultural industry.

Berry farmer, Walter Knott, helped fund the Lions Community Clubhouse that was completed in 1951. Because the City of Stanton did yet not exist, the clubhouse provided a place for community functions.

The Lions also developed and operated *Stock Lions Park* which served the community with ball fields for the local Little League. The park was later sold off and the proceeds were used to help charity.

Today's Lions have continued on in this tradition of helping the community.

WHAT STANTON LIONS DO

Currently, we have several service projects and raise money for charity. Lions participate in Stanton's Summer-Fest and donate a bicycle to a child every year.

Lions also work with local doctors to make sure low-income and uninsured families can provide vision care for their children. Lions also collect used eyeglasses that are recycled for those in need overseas. We are very proud of the Leos Club we sponsor at the Braille Institute.

Every year, Stanton Lions visit a local school to educate children about our flag and what it means to be a US citizen.

We also raise money for charity by renting out the Lions Clubhouse, selling mints, selling coupon books, and have an annual pancake breakfast.
