Stanton Lions Build Youth Center

Stanton Lions are constructing a youth center building on the two acre Stock Lions Park in Stanton, Bill T. Asawa, club president, announced to-day. The 1580 square foot structure will house scout, cub scout, brownie, girl scout, and other boys and girls work activities.

The building is being built through funds raised by the Lions club in various community activities and through the donations of work and materials by interested business firms and private citizens of the West County area. First funds placed in the building treasury, according to Royal C. Marten, building secretary-treasurer, were a check for \$5000 from the James Irvine Foundation and \$1500 from a special fund raised for the purpose by the Stanton Lions.

Building chairman for the project is Calvin L. Pebley, while the committee includes Marten, Merrill Joy, Arvid Johnson, and Dan Cobb. A member of the Stanton Lions club, Mura S. Muraoka, is architect for the building. His plans as approved by the Board of Directors of the club envision a large community hall, kitchen
